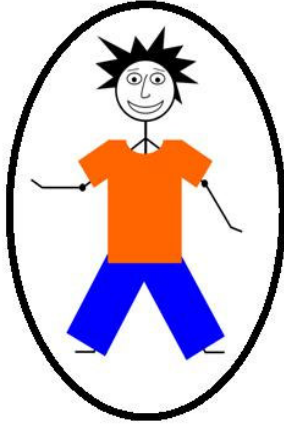


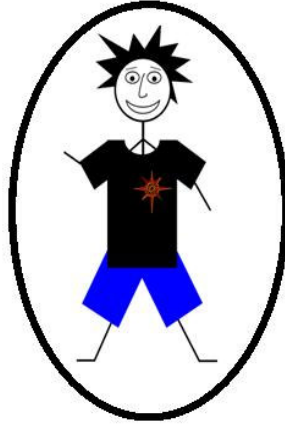
Dress Code



Shoes must be worn at all times.



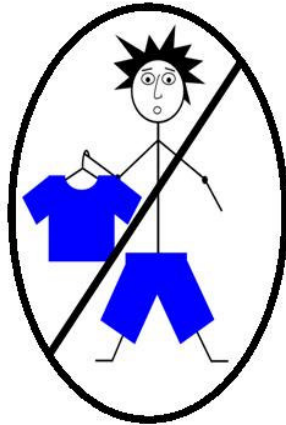
Dress Casual. Jeans & T-Shirts are great—even at evening services



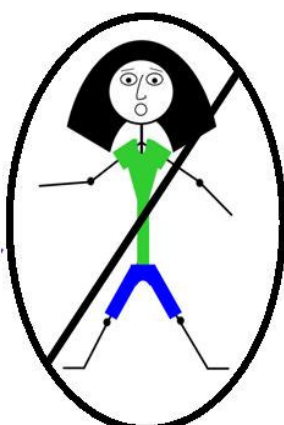
Shorts are great too!
No shorter than 4 inches above the knee



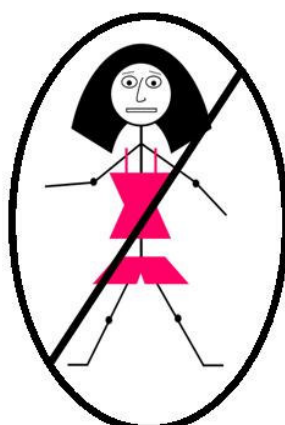
Girls can wear dresses or skirts if they want, no shorter than 4 inches above the knee (Boys cannot)



Shirts must be worn at all times



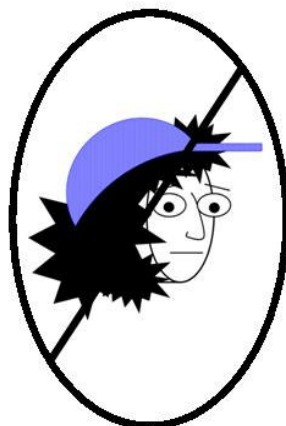
Please no tight shirts, pants, sweaters, or shorts. That goes for girls & boys. NO SPANDEX!



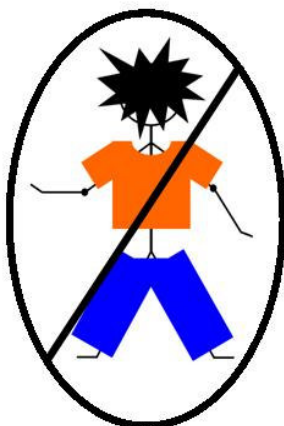
YIKES! No spaghetti straps or tank tops, bare mid-riffs or short shorts. Sleeveless tops ok. No split sides.



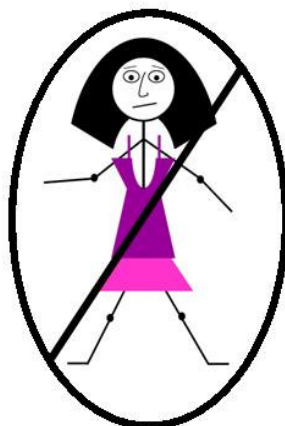
Please guys, no tank tops or short shorts! Sleeveless shirts are ok. But no split sides.



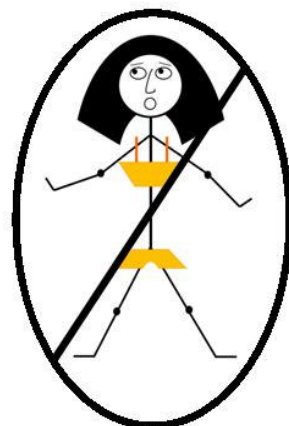
No caps or hats in buildings!

for everyone at camp, the following criteria will be expected from each camper:

Attitude - Christian conduct and character is expected to be evident at all times.

Time - You will be expected to follow the schedule. No one should be absent from classes except in case of sickness and then only on the advice of the Medical Technician. No visitors will be allowed to interfere with the camper's regular activities.

Missing - You will not be permitted to leave the grounds except for scheduled excursions.

On & **O**ff - Your clothing should be of a modest nature. The standards of the world are not the standards of Camp Northward. Shirts and clothing promoting alcohol or tobacco products, suggestive statements, grotesque scenes, or other graphics not consistent with a Christian environment may not be worn or displayed. Please see dress code for more details.

Sickness - All sickness and accidents must be reported to your counselor or camp nurse.

Protect - Each camper must protect and keep in order all Camp property.

Healthy - Tobacco, alcoholic beverages, drugs, illegal items, and other such products, undesirable language and other habits that are handicaps to growing youth are not part of the camp program and are not permitted.

Education - To maximize the camp experience—radios, cellular phones, pagers, tape/CD players, “gameboys”, skateboards, rollerblades, in-line skates, knives, squirt guns, walkie-talkies, etc. should not be brought.

Rights - While at camp your rights will be determined by the Golden Rule of Christ. Christianity is and always has been a religion based on “denying ones self” principle. This principle will affect what you say, what you do, what is expected of you, and what you can expect from others.

Emergency - For the benefit of the camper, telephone usage will be for emergency use only. Campers should plan to communicate with their parents and friends by writing. **Do not bring cell phones.**
